- Individuals league shooting 250 birds for class, then shooting 50 birds for position.
- April 1—May 27 (9 weeks)
  - Shoot 250 birds to establish class
- June 1—June 10 (2 weeks)
  - Shoot 50 birds to establish position within class.
- June 15
  - Shoot-off if needed
- \$5.00 league fee / person
- \$8.00 trap fee / 25 rounds
- Unlimited shoot ahead except for the position round. Must have 10 scores (250 birds) by May 27
